



Southeastern Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police 2022 College Scholarship Program

The Southeastern Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police announces the **2022 SEMACP College Scholarship Program**. Under the Program, two (2) \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded to two individuals based on the requirements below.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * A high school senior currently enrolled in Macomb, Oakland, St. Clair, Washtenaw and Wayne County public or private school. Homeschooled students are eligible if they reside in Macomb, Oakland, St. Clair, Washtenaw or Wayne County.
- * Applicants must be accepted by an accredited university or college as a full-time student in 2022.
- * Applicants should demonstrate the need of financial assistance in order to continue their education.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor, Principal or Instructor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- * Applications must be a dependent child of an active member of the Southeastern Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police.

Electronic submission of a completed and typed application package should be sent to: steppeyh@michigan.gov with a subject line of *2022 SEMACP Scholarship Submission* **by May 2, 2022**. Any application received after May 2, 2022 will not be considered.
(This includes application with signoff by Guidance Counselor, essay, and letter of recommendation)

The applications will be reviewed and recipients will be selected by the Southeastern Michigan Chiefs of Police Scholarship Committee. The scholarships will be awarded **June 2, 2022** during the monthly SEMACP meeting.
